1:31	G	You (Mary) will conceive and give birth to what? <i>A son, and you are to call him Jesus</i>
1:31	FTV	You - will - conceive - and - give ... <i>Birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus.</i>
1:31	FT2V	You - will - conceive - and - give ... <i>Birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus. * He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David,</i>

6:30	G	What if anyone takes what belongs to you? <i>Do not demand it back</i>
Luke 6:31	Type	Do to others as you would have them do to you.
6:31	G	Do to others how? <i>As you would have them do to you</i>
Luke 6:32	Type	Quote: If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners love those who love them.
6:32	G	What if you love those who love you? <i>What credit is that to you?</i>
6:32	G	Even sinners love whom? <i>Those who love them</i>
6:32	FTV	If - you - love - those - who ... <i>Love you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners love those who love them.</i>
6:32	Q	Quote Luke 6:32 <i>"If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners love those who love them."</i>
Luke 10:1	Type	After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go.
